The trip to the Historic Dockyards has come round and so this Saturday we're off for the day!

## Travel Arrangements

We will be traveling by train from Guildford to Portsmouth Harbour. Can you drop off your Cub at the main entrance to Guildford Station between 09:00 and 09:15? We won't be waiting for later comers! Please can your Cub bring the following items with them:

- Cub Uniform – at least the jumper and group scarf (if your Cub has not been invested then ignore this one).
- Weather appropriate clothing. We'll be outside effectively all day, so warm and waterproof coats please, hats and gloves if it is looking particularly cold.
- A packed lunch, as we have nut allergies in the group so I can please ask you to avoid including any nuts.
- Up to £5 spending money.
- A camera if you wish.
- A rucksack or similar to carry all of their bits and bobs in.

We are aiming to catch the 16:15 train back, arriving back in Guildford at 17:15. I will post on the Cranleigh Scout Group Website ([www.cranleighscoutgroup.org](http://www.cranleighscoutgroup.org)) when we're on the train with the confirmed arrival time just in case we leave earlier/later than.

We will wait inside the main entrance when we arrive back and we'll only release Cubs to parents who come up to collect them from us, rather than sending them out into the dark to waiting cars.
